

Policy

Families with children enrolled at ASCS have the opportunity to offset tuition for the following school year. In order to qualify for the tuition offset, following must be met:

- a. All tuition, scrip fee and other ASCS fees must be current.

Any additional scrip profit accumulated by the ASCS family during the current scrip year, after the family scrip fee is met, will be credited to the ASCS family account at a rate of 50%. The scrip profit accumulated in this account can be applied to a child's tuition for the following school year. The remaining 50% of accumulated scrip profit will be deposited to the scrip fund.

Any family who withdraws student enrollment from ASCS will forfeit any remaining balance in their ASCS scrip family account to ASCS.

Note: The Scrip year begins the 3rd Monday of May, after the week's normal processing has been completed, and ends the following year's 3rd Monday of May.
